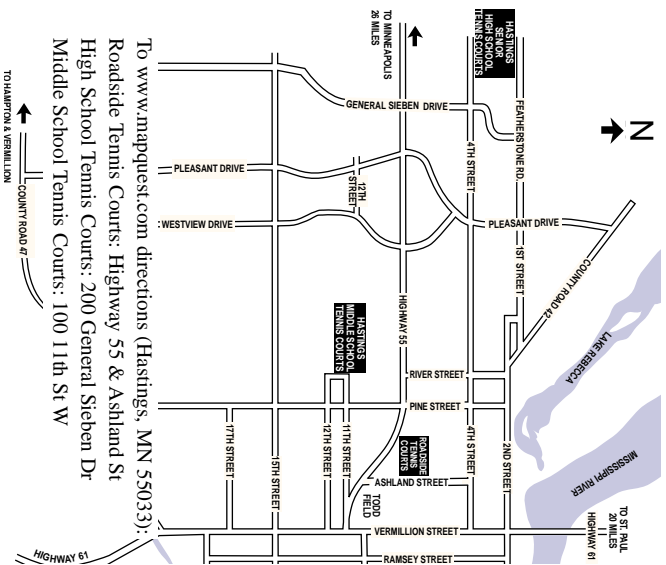

**Hastings Rivertown Days
Tennis Tournament Information**

Friday, July 20 – Sunday, July 22, 2007

1. Check in with court attendant at assigned location. Attendant will assign you to a court.
2. Observe court etiquette.
3. Five minute warmup allowed.
4. A 10-game pro set will be played. First player to win 10 games, with a margin of 2, wins match.
5. A 7 of 12 point tie breaker will be used at set score 10-10. The first player to get 7 points, with a margin of 2, wins.
6. Call your own lines and foot faults.
7. Winner of spin has choice of serving or receiving.
8. Open either can of balls. Winner keeps unopened or best balls; loser keeps balls played with.
9. You are guaranteed 2 matches. If you win the first match, you advance into the winner's bracket; if you lose the first match, you advance into the consolation bracket. Once a player advances into the winner's bracket, the player may not enter the consolation bracket.
10. Report score and winner to court attendant.
11. Check boards for next match. In round robins, you may play more than 2 matches before being eliminated.
12. Good luck and have fun!
